

WATTAGEE PROJECT- RC DRILLING UPDATE

- **Wattagee RC drilling to commence 1st April 2010.**
- **Heritage survey cleared all proposed drill sites.**
- **Enterprise expands tenement footprint ahead of drilling.**

Enterprise Metals Limited (“Enterprise” or “the Company”, ASX: “ENT”) wishes to announce that the Native Title Claimants for the Wattagee area have completed a heritage survey of the proposed drill sites and all drill lines are cleared. The 6 hole RC drilling program to test the Placer, Stockyard and AM 14 prospects will now commence Thursday 1st April 2010. The commencement date of the program was delayed by several days due to excessive rain in the area.

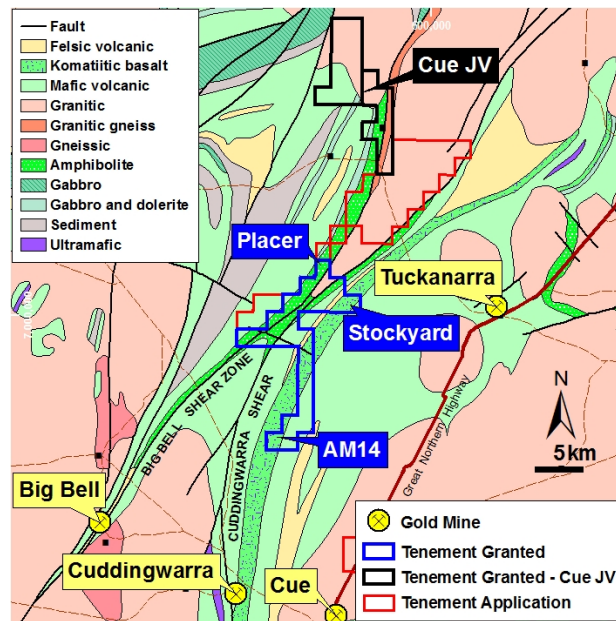


Figure 1. Location & Geology Plan – Wattagee Project

The Company has also entered into an Option Agreement with Lee Pasco (“Cue JV”) whereby the Company has the right to purchase an 80% interest (and form a joint venture) in 2 granted exploration licences and 1 prospecting licence which lie along the Big Bell Shear Zone adjacent to Wattagee. (refer Figure 1 below) Exploration on these adjacent tenements has commenced.
